TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS DUE TO COVID-19

Given the announcement by the Honourable Prime Minister on 25 March 2020, this notice serves to inform all maritime stakeholders that effective from 0001hrs on Sunday, 29 March 2020, all passenger travels to outer islands will cease.

All marine clearances will cease from 0001 hours on 29 March 2020 until further notice. However, ships carrying cargo will continue with increased volume but decreased frequency to ensure food and other essential goods are supplied to the islands.

All movements in and out of Lautoka Port will continue to be suspended until further notice.
