1.4.4	Have completed not less than 18 months of sea going service on ships powered by main engine of more than 750kW propulsion power, in a position of responsibilities in the engine department whilst holding a certificate as Engineer Class 4; or		
1.4.5	Have completed not less than 36 months of approved sea going service on ships powered by main engine of above 750 kW propulsion power. 30 months of the approved seagoing service must be served in the engine department of which should include not less than 6 months watch keeping duties under supervision of chief engineer or a qualified engineer, whilst holding an Engine Watch Rating Certificate; or		
1.4.6	Have completed not less than 24 months of approved sea going service on ships powered by main engine of above 750Kw propulsion power. 12 months of the approved sea service should include watch keeping duties under the supervision of chief engineer or a qualified engineer, whilst holding an Able Seafarer Engine certificate (CoP).
