- The nominated ship(s) should be attached to the mooring at all times unless in operation or at another location for repair/maintenance. Due to the increased demand for mooring space, a buoy mooring(s) should not be unattended for a period of more than 90 days continuously without notifying MSAF.
- Buoy mooring(s) are not for sale or transfer and must be used in accordance with the conditions placed on the owners.

- Consent of Customary Fishing Rights Owners**

- Nautical Chart**
A chart extract is to be provided clearly showing the position of the proposed buoy mooring defined by latitude and longitude in degrees and minutes to 3 decimal places. Distance from any adjacent property boundary. Coastal features and land boundaries adjacent to the proposed location. Relationship of the proposed buoy mooring by line of bearing or transit with at least two permanent marks.

- Other Agency Approvals**
Written approval from agencies where the proposed buoy mooring is affected by their policies, regulations or by-laws. For example but not limited to: Port / Marina operator, Local government, Department of Environment or Tourism.

- Passport Copy**
Provide a copy of valid passport of applicant.

- Plan Drawing**
Provide layout diagram of the mooring.

- Maintenance Report**
Provide an annual independent full underwater inspection report of each mooring buoy, showing the conditions of each mooring buoy a month prior to the expiration of the approval issued by the authority.
